## Conditions

List of names in Party must be given to the Professional unless otherwise arranged.

The Professional controls starting and his decision is final.

All play must commence at the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee unless otherwise arranged.

Club members not in the party may be given alternate times on busy occasions.

Parties playing in the afternoon must be clear of the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee by 4.30 pm.

The Rules and Etiquette of Golf as laid down by the R&A must be strictly observed adhering to along with any Local Rules in force.

Helensburgh Golf Club Dress Code and Health and Safety Requirements must be strictly observed.

Accurate numbers in the party must be notified not less than 48 hours before the visit to finalise Tee Bookings, Catering requirements and to **safeguard deposits**.

All accounts must be settled before departure.

## Dress Code

Normal dress in the Club House and on the Course is as follows:

Smart casual is the accepted norm; Gents tops should have sleeves and a collar.

Tailored shorts worn with sports socks or knee length hose are acceptable.

When attending Club Functions, Members and Guests are expected to be dressed to suit the occasion.

Outdoor apparel such as coats, waterproofs etc should be left in the Locker Room or on the Coat Rack provided.

Spiked Golf shoes are permitted within the Changing Rooms and defined areas of the Club House but not in the main lounge.

Golf Shoes on the Course are an essential safety requirement.

House Manager, Club Professional and Committee members have the authority to ask any member or visitor not dressed appropriately to leave the Club House or Course.

Prohibited at all times either in the Club House or on the Course:

Wearing of Football / Rugby shirts or football colours, Track Suits or Shell Suits.

Specifically:

Blue Jeans may not be worn on the Course at any time.
